

# DISH Pro Plus Technology

### Highlights

- DISH Pro Plus receivers can be connected with a single cable to DISH Pro Plus switches or LNBFs, when used with a DISH Pro Plus Separator.
- Any DISH Network receiver can be connected to a DISH Pro Plus switch or LNBF; DISH Pro Adapters are not needed.
- By definition, "DISH Pro Plus" receivers have two satellite tuners.

### Features

- DISH Pro Plus Technology offers the following key advantages:
  - Connect DISH Pro Plus (dual-tuner) receivers to DISH Pro Plus switches and LNBFs using a DISH Pro Plus Separator and one cable.
  - Connect:
    - DISH Pro receivers
    - Legacy receivers, without a DISH Pro Adapter\*
- DISH Pro Plus Technology shares many similarities with DISH Pro Technology, including:
  - Longer cable runs - up to 200 feet.
  - Enhanced diagnostics.
  - Requires RG-6 cable and other components rated to 2150 MHz.
- Compatible with DISH Pro LNBFs and DP Plus switches.

### Benefits

- Requires less wiring and simplifies the installation of dual-tuner receivers.
- Leverages use of existing in-home RG-6 cabling for dual-tuner receiver installations, reducing installation time.
- Backward compatible with DISH Network legacy receivers (non-DISH Pro or non-DISH Pro Plus receivers) - no DISH Pro Adapter is needed, therefore reducing installation costs.
