VOOM'S RAVE HD TO PREMIERE THREE EXCLUSIVE NEW CONCERTS THIS MAY

CONCERTS INCLUDE "ELVIS COSTELLO: LIVE IN MONTREAL,"
"MONTREUX JAZZ FESTIVAL 2006" AND "SCOTTY MOORE &
FRIENDS: A TRIBUTE TO THE KING OF ROCK & ROLL"

On **May 4 at 10 P.M. E.T.**, Rave HD will premiere "**Elvis Costello: Live in Montreal.**" Rave HD will also premiere "**Montreux Jazz Festival 2006**" on **May 25 at 9 P.M. E.T.** and "**Scotty Moore & Friends: A Tribute to the King of Rock & Roll**" on **May 28 at 8 P.M. E.T.**

"Elvis Costello: Live in Montreal" witnesses Costello, one of the most versatile singer-songwriters of the last 30 years rekindle his friendship with New Orleans R&B icon **Allen Toussaint**. Recorded at Montreal's Place des Arts, the program reaches back to Costello's first album, 1977's *My Aim Is True*, and takes viewers on a tour of some of the most meaningful pop music of the last three decades. The concert highlights Costello's collaboration with Toussaint from their album, *The River in Reverse*, a tribute to Toussaint's music and a message of hope for post-Katrina New Orleans. With backing from Costello's band, The Imposters, and Toussaint's tight New Orleans horn section, the performance presents two enormously talented musicians in a touching tribute to the healing powers of music.

Featuring performances by **Sting**, **The Strokes** and **Iggy Pop & The Stooges**, Rave HD's presentation of "Montreux Jazz Festival 2006" highlights the 40th edition of the historic jazz event. Now drawing over 100,000 spectators a year, the Montreux Jazz Festival historically offers a diverse and avant-garde program that blends rock, electro pop, hip-hop, reggae, world music, soul and R&B. Established in 1967, the Montreux Jazz Festival has provided countless unforgettable musical moments and has highlighted monumental performances by artists such as Count Basie, Ella Fitzgerald, Aretha Franklin, Chuck Berry, B.B. King, Miles Davis, Van Morrison, Bob Dylan and Johnny Cash.

Filmed at London's Abbey Road Studios, "Scotty Moore & Friends: A Tribute to the King of Rock & Roll" features guitar greats **Eric Clapton**, **Mark Knopfler**, **Albert Lee** and **David Gilmour** as they pay tribute to Moore, Elvis Presley's influential guitarist. Moore, accompanied by **Charlie Watts** and **Bill Wyman** of The Rolling Stones, revisits 27 of Elvis Presley's biggest hits. The special also features interviews with each of the performers, in which many claim that Moore's guitar playing is what inspired them to pick up the instrument for the first time.
