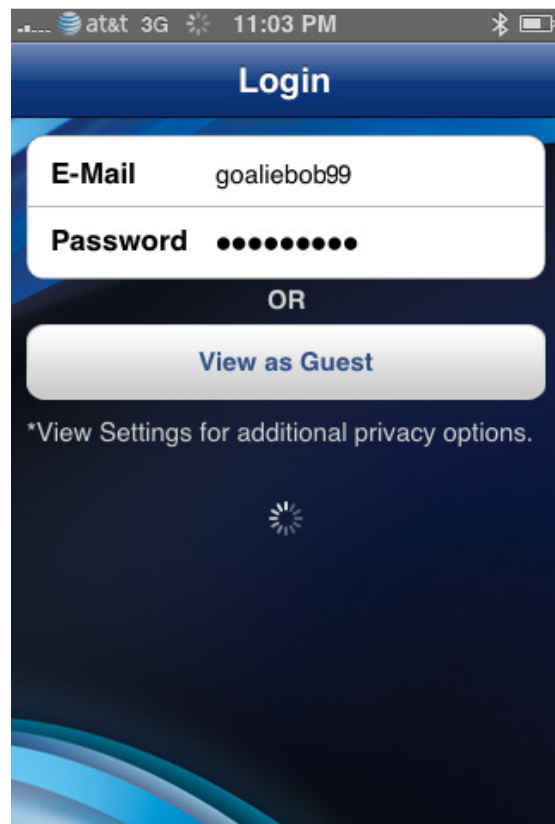
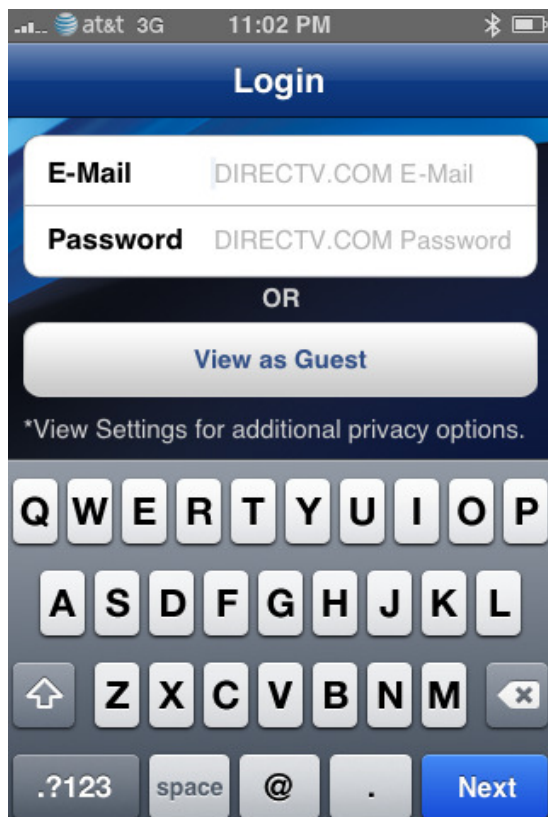
## LAUNCHING AND NAVIGATING THE APPLICATION

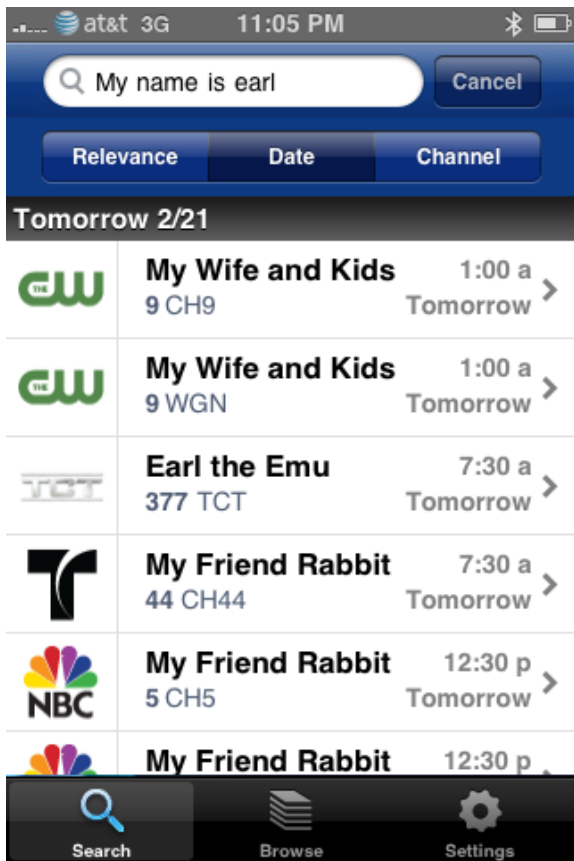
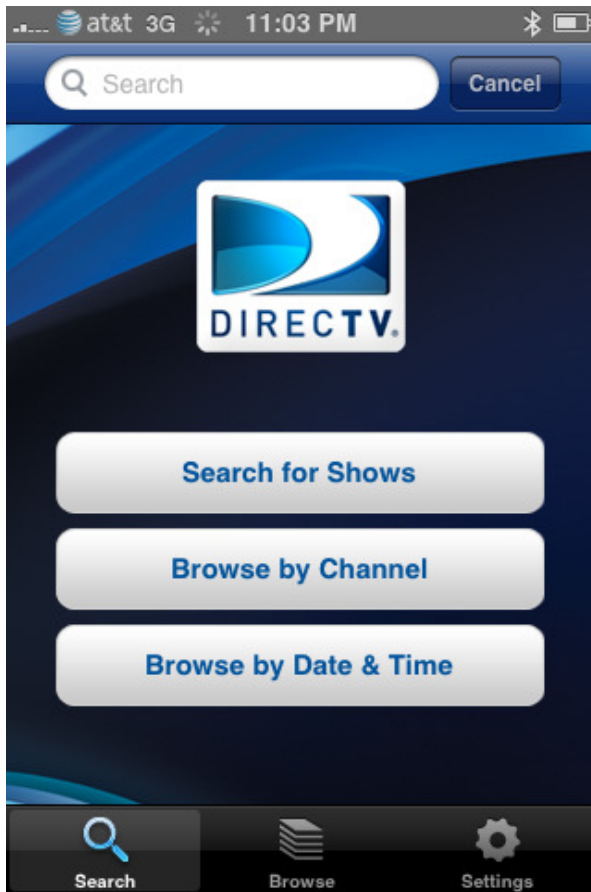


Upon downloading the tool from the Apple store (coming 03/30/2009) you will see the program install like any other iPhone Application. A DirecTV application icon will appear on your iPhone desktop and from there you can touch the program and it will begin to load.

Upon loading, you will be prompted for your Directv.com email and Password. Entering this information will allow you to unlock the possibilities of the iPhone application as well as unlocking your entertainment possibilities while abroad.

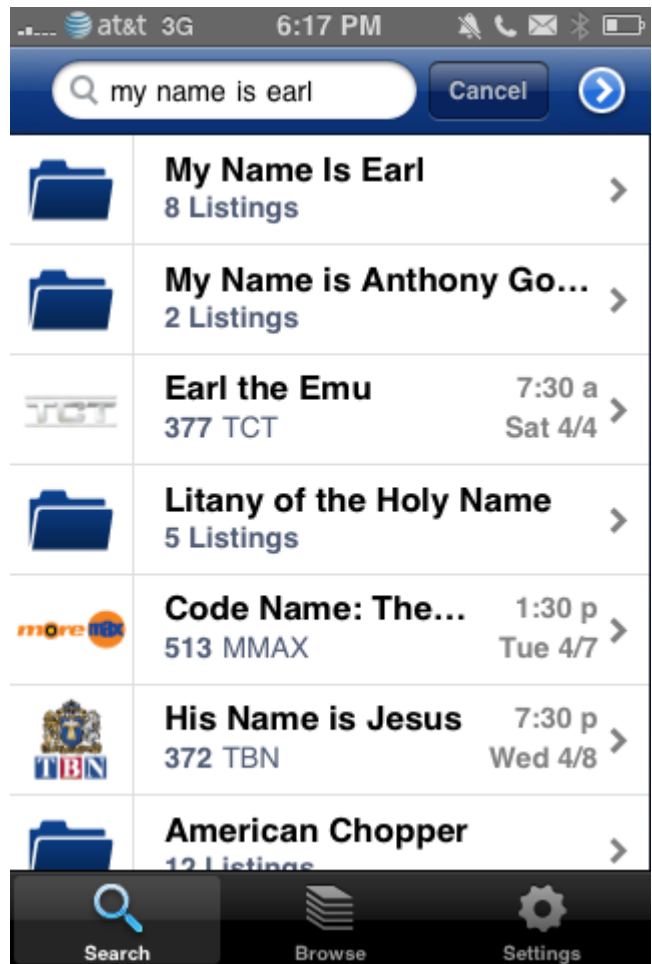
Also, this will allow your iPhone to communicate to DirecTV and your receivers at home.





After you have completed your Directv.com account information the program loads and you are now presented with three options as well as a search box. You can search for shows, by channel, or by date and time.

Within the search box you can manually search for a show such as My Name is Earl by utilizing your touch screen keyboard to enter the program name.



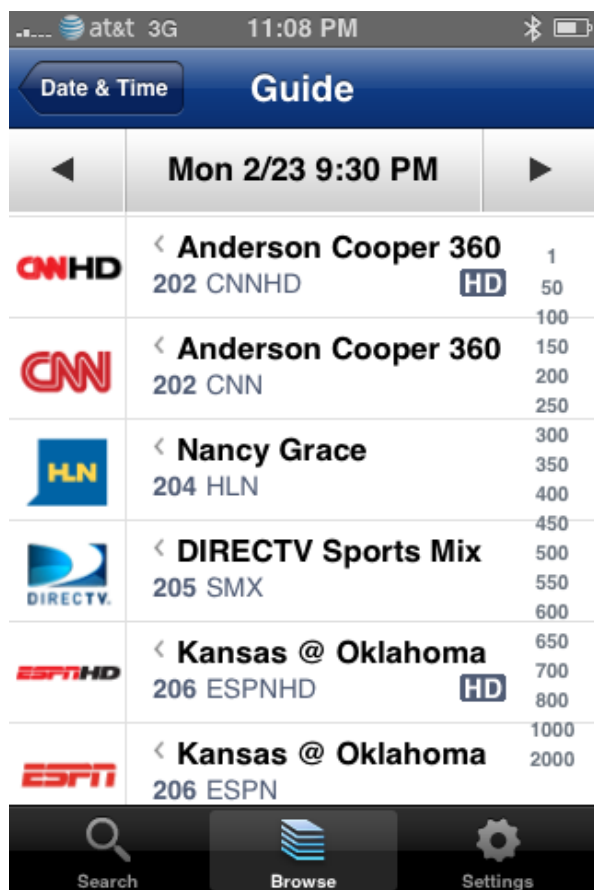
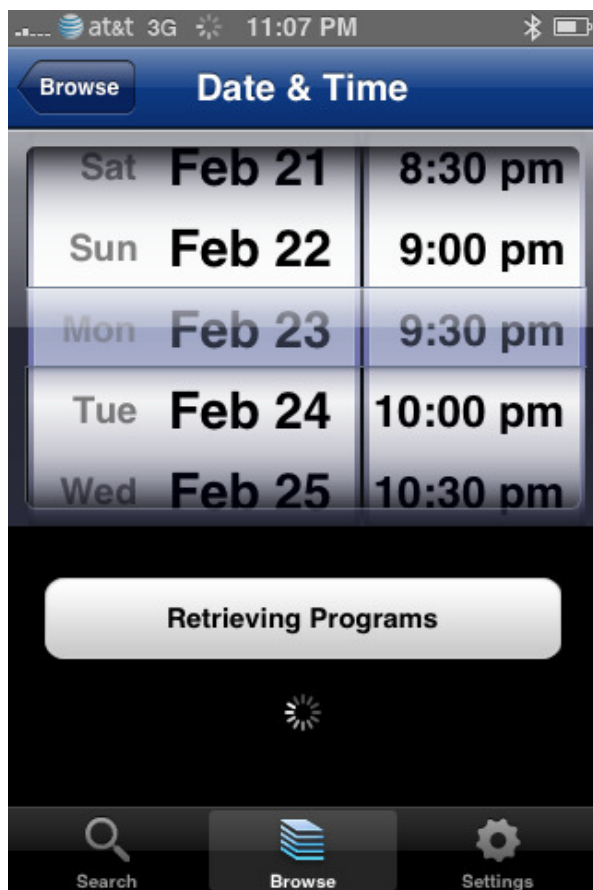
You can now use your index finger to scroll through the list contents by sweeping it in an up and down motion to scroll and see what is on. If you find a program that you would like to record, Select it by tapping on it and you will be taken to the record screen which we will discuss later.





You also have the ability to schedule recordings on your iPhone using the search by channel feature. This will display a list of the channels you subscribe to including your local channels. You can now select the channel to see what is airing.

Using the search by Date and Time feature, you can now select any date and time that DirecTV has program guide data for and channel surf to set your recording. For faster scrolling you can scroll via the right side of the screen and retrieve your channels faster as the guide will now scroll via the 100's, 200's and so forth. This is a neat little feature that allows virtual channel surfing on the go.



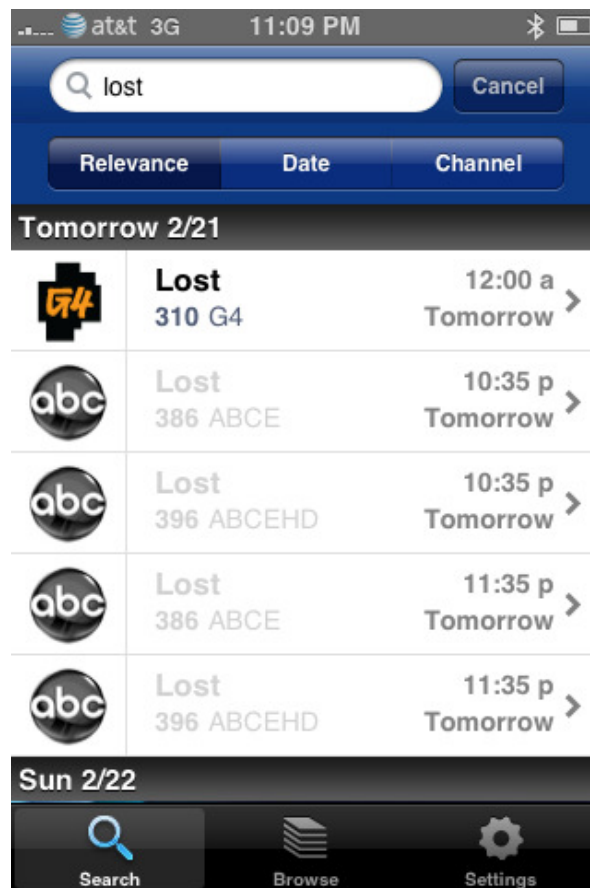
## SETTING UP TIMERS AND APPLICATION SETTINGS

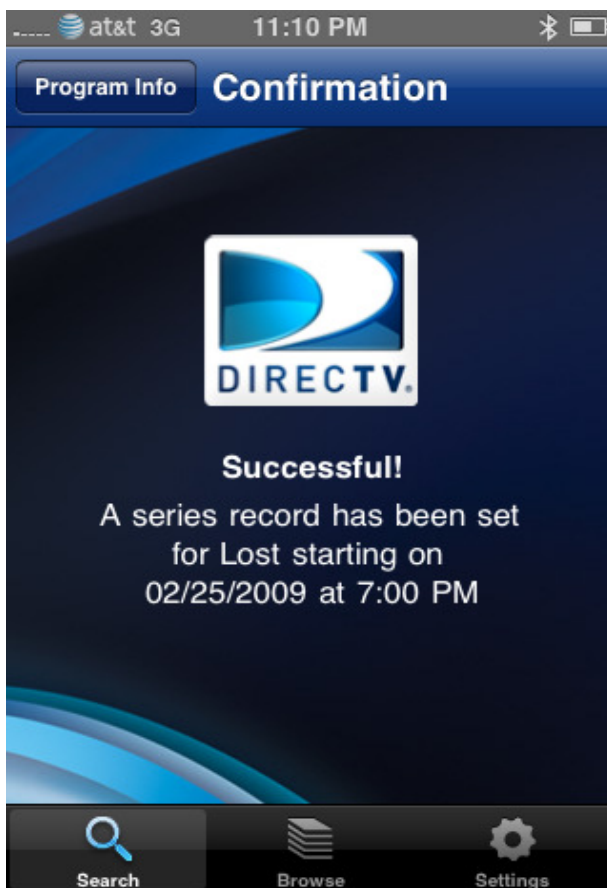
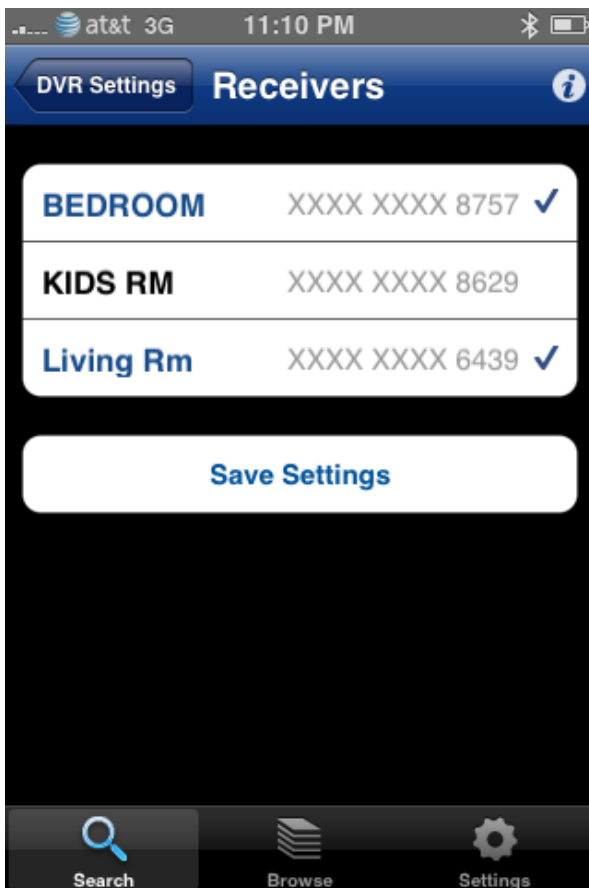
As discussed earlier, we have found that I forgot to record lost on ABC and have done a search for the program Lost. The DirecTV iPhone application has found the potential program that I wanted to record and has grayed out channels that I don't subscribe to. Using my finger I have now scrolled to my local ABC affiliate WLS DT7 and have selected the program. A program Info screen now appears with the program information. You now have the option of recording the episode only or setting up a series pass. In this case I have setup a series pass so I never miss an episode again. Upon tapping the record this series or record this episode button, I am now presented with which receivers I would like to record to. You can now record to multiple or single receivers.

I would love to watch lost in both my main living room, as well as in my bed room so I set both to record season passes on both receivers. Next, I tap on save settings button and I now have the options of the priority I would like to record as well as keeping until the disk is full or until I delete it. Upon clicking record this program, I receive a conformation screen and the iPhone sends this information over the internet to DirecTV. In turn DirecTV now sends a signal via the satellite to my receivers to record Lost on WLS-DT DirecTV channel 7-1 on both of my Living room and Bedroom High Definition sets.

Upon going home to my receivers, I have confirmed that lost is indeed set to record.

As one can see, setting up a recording is as simple as 123. Maintaining the iPhone application is just as easy. Directv has simplified the process. By using your finger to select the settings option, you now have access to the programs settings. You have the option to show only the channels you get, versus all channels. You can hide all adult channels, as well as setting time zone options.

This application is really cool and could be made perfect with remote sling capabilities. It is a perfect way of setting recordings without having to go through the [moble.directv.com](http://moble.directv.com) experience. It simplifies everything and provides you with a way to setup those recordings just in time, before you miss that big game you forgot about!
