


Some Ideas On Primestar Dish Bracket To Fit SG2100 HH Motor Drives.


Here are *some* of the great ideas that was posted in the SatellitesGuys.us. There are soooo many posted! Some of these pictures were found in the “Primestar Dish on SG2100” thread. My setup is based from guys such as *DirtyShame*.

The weight of the Primestar original mount is almost nine pounds. That would be a lot weight for the SG2100. By adapting to one of these homemade mounts, you can knock off as much as 7 pounds. The lighter the mount, the less stress on the SG2100. The SG2100 can handle up to a 1.2 meter dish.
