**ORDER GRANTING AGREED MOTION FOR ENTRY OF
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AGAINST DEFENDANTS**

Having considered the Agreed Motion for Entry of Preliminary Injunction, the court file in this matter, and the applicable law this Court finds that the parties' request for a preliminary injunction in the form of the temporary restraining order previously issued by this Court, and continuation of the impoundment of seized items, is **GRANTED**.

IT IS ORDERED that Defendants Sonysat LLC and Juan Martinez, and any of their officers, agents, servants, employees, and those acting in active concert

or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Order, are enjoined from directly or indirectly:

(a) manufacturing, importing, offering to the public, providing, or otherwise trafficking in Sonysat branded receivers, X² dongles, software files, or other devices that are used in circumventing the DISH Network security system or intercepting DISH Network programming;

(b) offering to the public or providing services that assist others in circumventing the DISH Network security system or intercepting DISH Network programming, including the operation or support of an IKS server;

(c) receiving or assisting others in receiving without authorization DISH Network's satellite signals or other electronic communications originating from DISH Network's system;

(d) transferring, removing, encumbering, or permitting withdrawal of any assets or property belonging to Defendants, whether real or personal, tangible or intangible, including cash, bank accounts of any kind, stock accounts, bonds, and title to Defendants' business property;

(e) destroying, hiding, or altering any books or records, whether in hard copy or electronic form, concerning the satellite receiver business or finances of Defendants, including invoices, purchase orders, receipts, shipping records, banking or investment records, or any documents that identify manufacturers,


exporters, importers, dealers, or purchasers of Sonysat receivers, X² dongles, software for these devices, or persons involved in operating any IKS server or receiving control words from same;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the preliminary injunction shall take effect immediately and remain in effect pending entry of a final judgment or further order of this Court;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all items seized from Defendants are to remain impounded in the custody of DISH Network pending further order of this Court. DISH Network is permitted to return particular seized items to Defendants if agreed to by the parties. Defendants may inspect the seized items if agreed to by the parties, or upon order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the \$50,000 bond posted with the Court by DISH Network is no longer required and shall be returned to DISH Network in full.
